Louisiana Region R5 ESF-8 Health & Medical Coalition Meeting, met on Monday, January 23, 2023, to discuss -

- Discussed ATT Outage:
 - The ATT Outage Hotwash/Debrief was distributed to the attendees. Jason Lionberger described the timeline of the event. He also explained the different communication assets that were being deployed and how the outage affected the 700 MHZ radios.
 - Possible alternative communication devices were discussed including the use of VHF and/or UHF walkie-talkies. Paul DeStout explained Calcasieu Parish was in the process of creating another redundancy that would prevent such an outage. Jason Lionberger explained the following:
 - It is an 800mhz radio system that will backup LWIN. This system will work on microwave tower sites within Calcasieu Parish. This will be utilized when the 700mhz state LWIN system goes down. This project will be completed within the next 1-2 years.

 - Mike Parent, OPH reviewed the use of the 700 MHZ radios
 - \circ Liz Harmon reminded everyone to identify themselves when using the radios.

• Discussed – Public Health Update-Opioid Data:

- Tr. Cavanaugh, Regional Medical Director presented the following
 - o Overdose deaths in Calcasieu Parish in 2022 (preliminary) were 65
 - This is a drastic decrease from 100 overdose deaths reported in Calcasieu in 2021
 - We believe this decrease is significant and is a testament to the efforts of many agencies across the region (including hospitals) working collaboratively to implement interventions
 - o In other regions of Louisiana, preliminary reports have not shown drastic decreases as we have
 - 0 65 is still too many deaths, and we still have a long way to go, but it's definitely progress!
 - Of the 65 deaths in 2022, the large majority (around 90%) had a history of substance use disorder, but only about 21% had a known history of seeking care
 - Fentanyl was involved in 77% of the deaths, but, most of these involved other substances (such as methamphetamines and benzodiazepines) in addition to fentanyl
 - o Melissa Stainback forwarded the Stats compiled by the Coroner's Office

Strong to severe thunderstorms are possible later today as a squall line sweeps across the region. Timing will be early afternoon for SE TX and SW LA and Acadiana by evening. All modes of severe weather will be possible, with the greatest threat for tornadoes in portions of central LA into MS. Make sure you have a way to receive warnings later today.





• Issued at 6:40AM CST Tuesday, February 7, 2023

- There will be a Slight Risk Potential (level 2 out of 5) for severe storms on Wednesday afternoon into Wednesday evening as a storm system moves into the region. Storms are likely to form along a line and move west to east across southeast Texas into southwest, south central, central Louisiana during the late afternoon into evening hours. Some of these storms will have the potential to produce damaging wind gusts and/or quick spin-up tornadoes. Also, some locally heavy rain may fall with a small potential for flooding.
- Until the storms move in, expect warm and humid conditions.
- The weather aware and keep updated on the potential severe situation on Wednesday.
