

WEATHER UPDATE (NWS): Doug Cramer, Warning Coordination Meteorologist -

Discussed - US National Weather Service Lake Charles Louisiana:

• Good morning, SW Louisiana & SE Texas

Showers and thunderstorms will increase in coverage by the afternoon as a frontal boundary slowly sags southward across the area. Otherwise, it looks to be a partly to mostly cloudy day with highs ranging from the upper 80s well inland to lower or mid 90s from the Highway 190 corridor to the coast. Winds will be southwesterly or westerly south of the front, while they will be northwesterly to northerly behind the front...speeds will run at 5 to 10 mph. Have a great day!

• FIRST ALERT FORECAST – Tuesday, September 12, 2023



TAKE CHARLES, La. (KPLC) - Hurricane Lee is a major hurricane again north of the Leeward Islands.



Right now, indications are that it will continue to slowly move on a west-northwest to northwest track through Wednesday. Later this week Lee will accelerate northward and likely lose strength as it passes near Bermuda and then eventually New England by this weekend. Obviously, Hurricane Lee poses NO threat to Southwest Louisiana.



The Behind it, Hurricane Margot is moving north into the open Atlantic and poses no threat to anyone.



Elsewhere, we are still watching a tropical wave near the coast of Africa. It should generally move on a northwesterly path into the tropical Atlantic, where a system may form later this week. Still, those disturbances are a few thousand miles away and nothing to be concerned about at this time. As always, we'll watch it and keep you updated if anything changes.

The mini-fall preview continues tonight with lows in the 60's and very dry air in place again tomorrow. We'll have at least another day or two of the warm, dry afternoons before a few showers and storms may return by the middle of the week.
