(<u>Meteorologist in charge</u>) - Andy Patrick and/or (<u>Meteorologist</u>) - Roger Erickson Discussed - Update for Downtown Lake Charles forecast for Friday, October 11, 2019 (President Trump Event)

- No significant updates to the forecast for Friday, October 11, 2019
- A cold front will move across Calcasieu Parish Friday afternoon, producing showers and thunderstorms
- A few of these storms could be strong to severe, with wind gusts of 40 to 60 mph and/or small hail
- Temperatures will be quite warm in front of the front, with highs in the upper 80s, but cool into the 60s behind the front Friday evening
- Winds will shift from the south at 15 mph and gusty in the afternoon to northwest at 15 mph and gusty in the evening
- Expect isolated power outages due to some of the stronger wind gusts
- Rain totals will be less than an inch, so flooding should not be a problem
