
<u>WEATHER UPDATE (NWS):</u> Doug Cramer, Warning Coordination Meteorologist – <u>KPLC 7 Weather First Alert Forecast, Wednesday, September 11, 2024: Chief Meteorologist, Wade Hampton:</u>

• Good Wednesday morning to you, SW Louisiana, latest in ornation on *Hurricane Francine* winds still 90 mph this is located about 140 miles southwest of Morgan City. The forecast unchanged on this and it will make landfall later on today maybe closer to 6:00 PM before landfall somewhere just east of Vermilion Bay. That keeps us on the good side of this and impacts are going to be limited with gusty winds 10 to 20 mph maybe occasionally 20 to possibly as high as 40 mph but it's going to be limited as far as winds are concerned Rain in the form of light showers will be possible really at any point through the rest of the afternoon but overall, I think most of it will be pretty light. And as I said eventually making landfall somewhere just east of Vermilion Bay. You can see futurecast showing some pretty strong winds near Houma and port Fourchon later on this afternoon with gust and excessive hurricane force maybe even into the New Orleans area early this evening, but impacts here limited...



US National Weather Service Lake Charles Louisiana, Wednesday, September 11, 2024:

• Chances favor Hurricane Francine to make landfall along the central Louisiana coast late this afternoon or early this evening as either a high-end Category 1 or a low end Category 2 Hurricane. In addition to damaging winds and dangerous storm surge, several inches of rain will fall over lower Acadiana and much of southeast Louisiana today and through tonight, creating a risk for flooding.
