

 - Wetter weather moved into SWLA Tuesday, and it looks like those umbrellas will still come in handy a while longer.
 - Another round of showers and storms is kicking off our Wednesday as a cold front moves through, so don't forget your umbrella or rain gear heading out the door! That won't be the last of it either, as intermittent showers will be possible throughout the day and a third round of potential storms and heavy showers may move through during the afternoon. Rainfall will be heaviest, north of I-10 and there is a small risk of localized flooding. Although the risk is relatively low and limited to areas that see too much rain fall in a short amount of time. The risk of severe weather is also very low, but not zero.
 - High temperatures for the day will once again range from the 70's to 60's depending on how much rain falls in your local area.



Once the cold front moves through in the evening temperatures will drop into Thursday. Thursday and Friday will bring afternoon highs only reaching the 60s while morning lows will be coolest Friday when most areas will reach the 40s!



For now, rain is largely out of the forecast for both Thursday and Friday. Although there may be some periods of time with clouds that could bring an occasional sprinkle or two.



Another cold front will approach SWLA on Saturday and this will bring another round of rain and storms to our area. If you have outdoor plans this weekend it would probably be best to avoid Saturday, but Sunday looks great with the rain out of the picture by then entirely.



- Saturday will be warm with highs near 80 degrees and then a sharp drop in temperatures arrives overnight into Sunday. Sunday may struggle to reach 60 for a high even with abundant sunshine. Morning lows will be chilly too with Monday being the coolest in the 30s in most areas.
- A warming trend begins again by the early part of next week with another cold front likely arriving later in the week. This will bring yet another round of rain to our area, but no signs of anything other than rain.




