#### **WEATHER UPDATE (NWS):** Doug Cramer, Warning Coordination Meteorologist –

Discussed - US National Weather Service Lake Charles Louisiana, Wednesday, March 12, 2025:

- Breezy today with a risk of severe storms this evening into tonight
- Stronger system arrives Friday, bringing strong winds and a risk of severe storms into Saturday

• Fair and seasonal weather returns Sunday into early next week









Discussed - LAKE CHARLES, LA (KPLC 7) Weather First Alert Forecast, Wednesday, March 12, 2025: Jacob Durham -

- High pressure remains mainly in charge for now, but that will change as we head through the overnight as a weak front approaches
- We'll still focus on plenty of sunshine and a gusty breeze heading to the afternoon as temperatures climb into the middle and upper 70s



- Clouds will be on the increase through the afternoon and especially the evening as the weak boundary slides in from the west
- Rain chances overall remain on the spotty side through the overnight with only a few stray showers while we are sleeping



- Quiet weather will quickly return heading into Thursday as we focus on abundant sunshine and a nice southerly breeze
- Thursday will likely be the first 80-degree day of the year as most locations may even climb a few degrees over the 80 threshold



- Spotty showers and storms return as we head into Friday afternoon as a more potent cold front begins to take shape north and west
- We'll still have to watch the potential for a stronger storm heading into Saturday, but trends continue to show the greater threat north and east



- High pressure will build back in heading into second half of the weekend keeping things nice and dry for Sunday
- Nice weather will stick around for much of next week as well with highs in the middle 70s before the next front heading into the middle of next week

Discussed - LAKE CHARLES, LA (KPLC 7) Weather First Alert Forecast, Tuesday, March 11, 2025: Jacob Durham -

• No complaints in the weather department as we head into our Tuesday as sunshine will be abundant with warming temperatures



- Highs will once again climb into the lower to middle 70s as winds have turned back out of the south and west
- It will be a little breezy throughout the day, but it'll make it very comfortable as well!
- A few clouds will begin to build as we head into Wednesday as moisture continues to increase ahead of a weak front Wednesday night into Thursday.



- Rain chances won't be widespread, but we may have just enough moisture in place we get a stray to spotty shower
- Our first 80 degree day looks to be on tap as well head into Thursday and even Friday as southerly winds really ramp up and coupled with sunshine.



- Friday will feature the change we have highlighted over the last week as showers and storms return to the forecast
- Spotty showers or a storm are possible heading into Friday afternoon, but most areas remain fairly quiet
- Better coverage of rain and storms arrives on Saturday and even then, it doesn't look like a total washout as the better coverage stays north and east



Quiet weather settles back in as we head into early next week with temperatures staying steady in the middle to upper 70s
