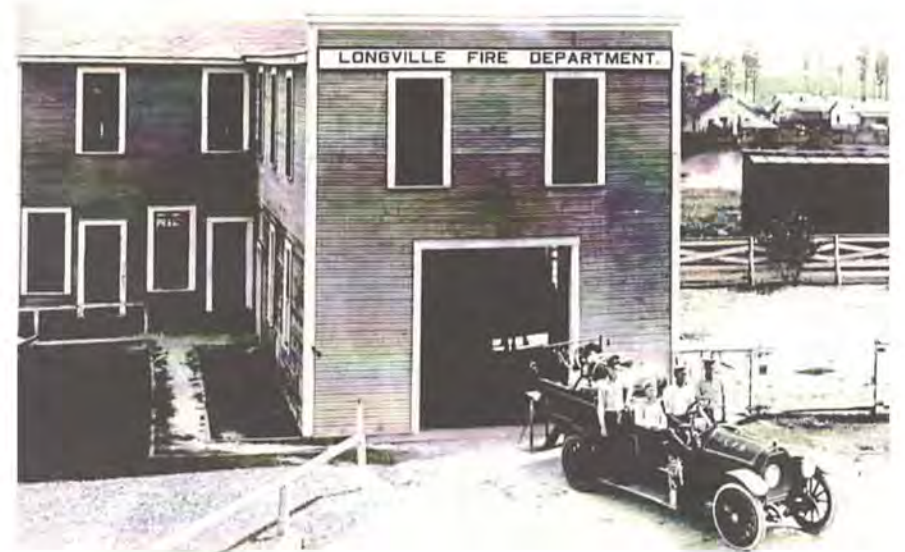

A full-time fire department was organized in Longville in 1910, following the 1907 charter of the Longville Lumber Company, a division of the Long-Bell Lumber Company.



There were 7 men who rotated shifts around the clock and a horse-drawn fire wagon, pulled by a horse named Dolly.

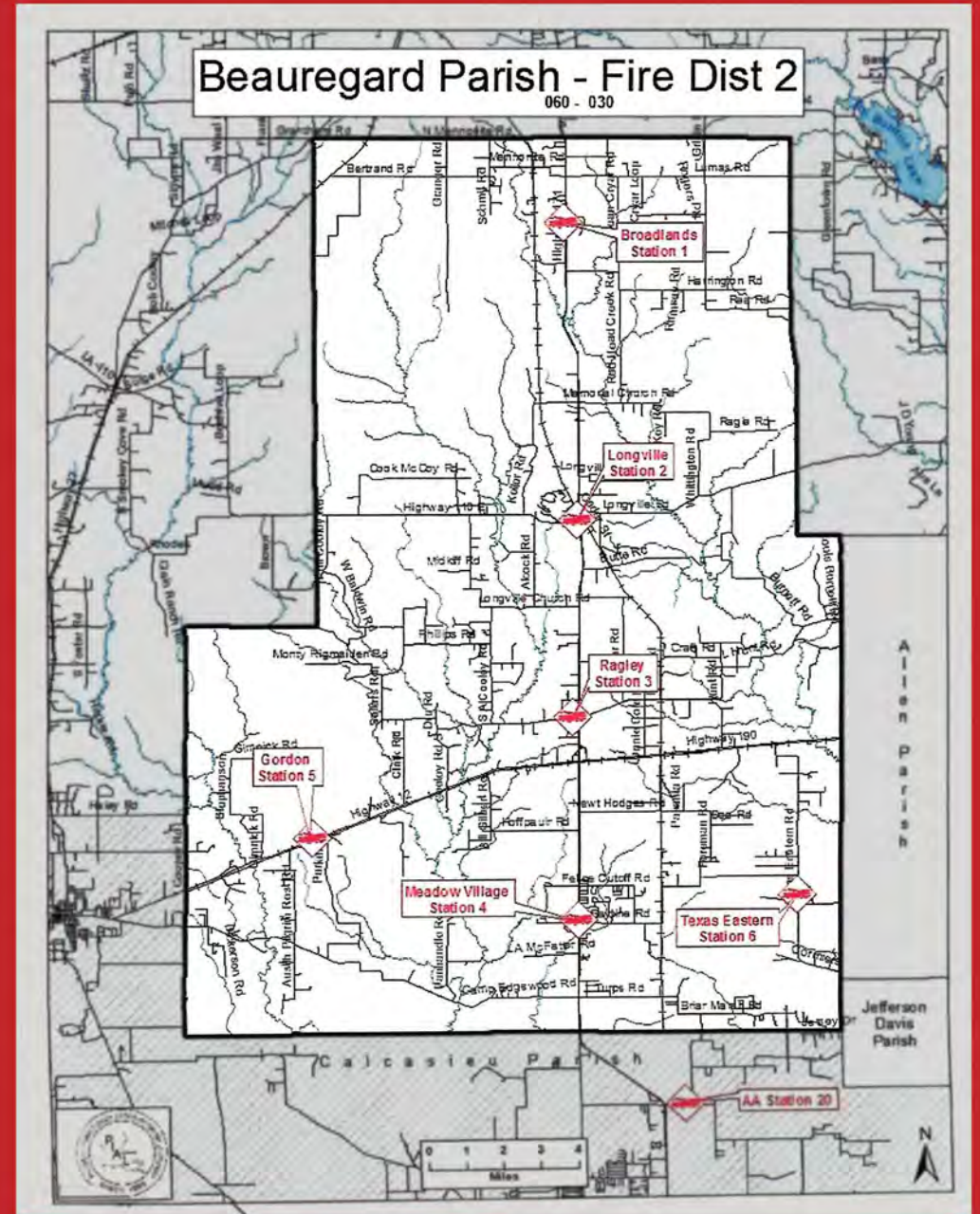
Eventually, a fire truck replaced the horse-drawn wagon.

- over 600 road miles of coverage area




Six Stations, One Department
